

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE | Genesis 12:1-9; 15:1-6

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we read God's call on Abram to leave all that he knew behind and travel to a new land that God would show him. We also see God's promise of a true heir. Because of Abram's faith in God's promises, he walked in obedience. Through Abram's life, we see that authentic faith will lead us to obey, resulting in God's blessing. Here are the main points:

- · Faith leads to obedience.
- · Obedience leads to reward.

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- Has God ever called our family to leave what and who we knew behind, or maybe to leave behind what was comfortable? Explain.
- God used the stars to reassure Abram. What images, occurrences, or people has God used to remind and reassure us of His promises?
- · How can our family imitate Abram's faith in our lives today?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Talk together about what following Jesus has cost each of you, with the adults starting the conversation. Consider things like jobs, relationships, plans, popularity, and so on. Be specific. Then, consider what you'd be scared or hesitant to give up if God asked. Spend some time praying together that we would remember the cost of God's gift of grace and be willing to give up anything to follow Him.
