

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE | Genesis 11:1-9

SESSION SUMMARY

This week, we meet some people who decided they wanted to make a name for themselves by building a city and a really tall tower. But God confused their language and scattered them. In this session, we can see that God will always accomplish His will for His glory. These are the main points:

- · Sin lures us into rebellion.
- · Our rebellion can't stop God's will.

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- · When has our family been motivated to make a name for ourselves? What happened?
- How can our family use all that we are and all of our skills to bring glory to God instead of seeking recognition for ourselves?
- · Where does our family need to trust in God's plan and authority right now?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

If you don't know them already, look up the meaning of each family member's name and discuss how that name fits that person's life and personality. Explain that names are important, and as God's name is the most important name, no matter what our names mean or what we do in life, all of it should point back to Him, giving Him glory and honor for who He is.
